



# New employee rights module information sheet

#### **Overview**

The new module is titled: "An Introduction to Your Employment Rights". Please note:

- It was designed to provide an entry-level module for users with limited English and/or reading abilities..
- It applies especially for those with limited English ability and/or time including: migrants, international students, domestic students, school leavers and other youth (15 to 25 years of age).
- It covers a 30-minute online lesson and short quiz that requires 8/10 to pass, plus a certificate for those who complete..
- It is available in six languages: English, Samoan, Hindi, Mandarin, Tagalog (Filipino) and Korean.
- It has a voice overs in all six languages for users who prefer to listen to rather than read the content.
- It is accessible by registering via https://employment.elearning.ac.nz/ or via https://www.employment.govt.nz/ then click "Know your rights"
- It allows employees to know their key essential employee rights in a fit-forpurpose format.
- It is mobile first friendly.
- It provides an entry-level module to the other advanced employee modules.

There are two types of end user:

- Primary: directed, those who are required to or strongly recommended to complete the module, for example by their employer or education provider or via a government agency to meet specific rules requirements.
- **Secondary**: self-directed, those who are primarily self-motivated to complete the module because they choose to do so without external influence.

# **Target Audiences**

Employees (current and future): Workers in industry training, International students, Migrants, Tertiary students, School leavers, Secondary students, Vulnerable workers and Employees in general.
